The purpose of the annual conference is to provide information on state-of-the-art practices in areas that promote quality community based life-styles for individuals with autism, deaf-blindness, and related disabilities. Conference participants will learn about current research findings and their implications as well as practical strategies related to communication and social interventions, transition to adulthood, positive behavior support, early intervention, and social and community inclusion.

- 5. Preference will be given to those who have not previously received a CARD scholarship.
- 6. Applicants who have been awarded a scholarship will need to register for the conference. You will need to create a UF Portal Account for reimbursement. Following the conference, you will need to submit your receipt and then you will be reimbursed by the University for the cost of your registration fee. Unfortunately, we cannot provide funds prior to the event nor reimburse for costs covering CEUs.
